Privacy Policy

Christian Camping International (CCI) respects your privacy and we want you to have the best experience possible on our website, whilst keeping your information and data secure. CCI is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected.

This privacy policy covers the website for CCI which is located at cciworldwide.org. The following information should help you to understand what information we collect, how it is used and what happens to it.

What information do we collect?

Non-Personal Information, such as IP address, pages viewed and files downloaded. This helps us to monitor the site's performance, determine how many people visit the site, identify what pages are most popular, and how regularly people visit. This helps us create a better experience for visitors.

Personal Information, such as name, address, telephone number, email address, is only collected in connection with specific activities, such as event registrations, purchases, feedback, and newsletter requests.

What happens to your personal information?

Your information, including emails, may be passed internally within CCI and our professional advisers to ensure you are connected with the right resources. All of these organisations are bound by strict confidentiality codes. Unless we have your express consent we will only disclose personal data to external third parties if this is required for the purpose of completing your transaction with us. To all our knowledge, these external third parties have sound data protection policies and systems.

We have the right to disclose your data when we are legally obliged to do so.

When submitting your personal information, you will be given the option not to be included in mailings from CCI. If you do not opt out of mailings at this point, but later decide that you no longer want to be contacted, you can inform us by emailing us or by clicking on the opt out 'unsubscribe' at the end of all mailings.

We do not sell, rent or trade your personal information to third parties for marketing purposes.

The Data Protection Act

Any personal information submitted via the CCI website is treated in accordance with the Data Protection Act (1998). This means that you have a right to advise us at any time if you no longer wish to receive mailings from us.

EU Cookie Legislation

Our office is based in the UK. We are mindful of the EU-wide 'Cookie Directive' that came into force for the UK in May 2012. All development on our website addresses compliance with this legislation.

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you agree, the file is added and the cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer of any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.

You can choose to accept or decline cookies. By using this website you agree in the use of cookies on this site.
